

## About the program:

Upon successful completion of this two-year program, students are expected to take the Commonwealth of VA State Cosmetology examination in order to become licensed practitioners. Students gain daily practical experiences working on other students and during their second year, have the opportunity to provide services to patrons in a clinical setting. Cosmetology students can also earn SOL credit for use toward the elective credit upon successfully passing the NOCTI credentialing exam and/or state licensing exam.
