Poquoson, Williamsburg/James City, Gloucester, and Isle of Wight Counties.

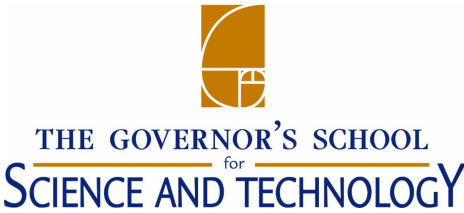
