### **COURSE-DESCRIPTION:**

BUILDING CONSTRUCTION I & II is the building block for achieving high-level construction industry skills that can result in an exciting and lucrative career, with a big emphasis on SAFETY. All students will take the OSHA 10 COURSE. Students are taught how to use hand tools and power tools. Students will learn how to cut stock wood from a tree, learn Construction Mathematics, and how to interpret blueprints. Students will become proficient in identifying different types of residential construction components consisting of foundations, framing, flooring, sheetrock, roofing, doors, decks, and porches. Students will gain in-depth knowledge and hands-on experience in construction skills. Throughout this school year they will find a trade that they will love.

- 11. Identify elements of floors, walls, ceilings and roofs

### DISCIPLINE:

If a student has a problem in class, the student will receive a verbal warning. If the problem continues, the parents will be notified. If that does not solve the problem, the student will report to the principal. If the offense is severe they may be sent to the principal the first time.

#### **MATERIALS FOR CLASS:**

Students must make up excuses within 5 working days of returning to class. The teacher will consider all absences unexcused until the student brings a note. Students' grades will be reflected in the days they miss. Construction class is like a job. A person cannot learn or contribute unless they are present.
