We proudly inducted 31 students into the National Technical Honor Society. Congratulations to our new members!

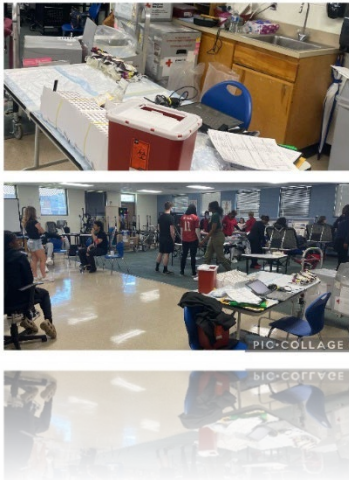


Community Service Projects

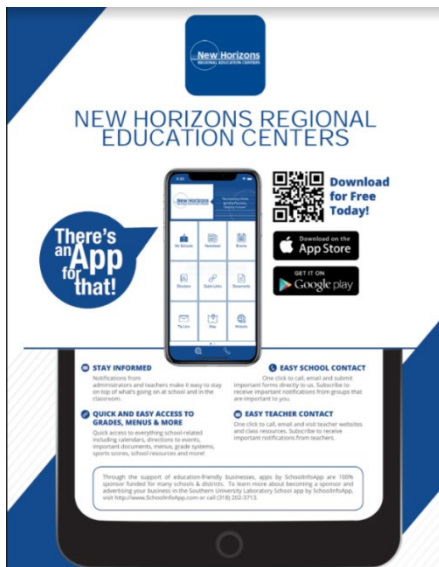
More Important News
