COURSE DESCRIPTION:

BUILDING CONSTRUCTION III will continue to focus on residential construction, including decking, framing, drywall, and interior construction. Construction III students are expected to be leaders and assist the Construction I & II students in instruction and safety. Construction III will hold positions such as: (1) Yard Foreman, (2) Shop Foreman, (3) Tool Foreman, (4) Material Foreman, (5) Supply Foreman, and (6) Safety Foreman. All Foremen will report to the Instructor, be responsible, and take the job seriously. Construction III students will complete all theory assignments online in Pearson.
