### RULES:

- 5. Personal protection equipment (PPE) should be worn upon entering the Lab. No shorts, pajamas, sweats, flip flops, Crocs, or house slippers. You may wear jeans or other types of pants, steel-toe or composite shoes/boots. Proper safety gear must be worn in the shop area. If you are not wearing proper PPE, you will sit in the classroom along the window wall, so that you can safely observe the day's lesson; however, you will lose all employability points for that day.
- 6. Remember to respect everyone!
- 7. Make sure you have your materials every day in class; consistently asking for paper or pens is disruptive to class. Maintain a 3-ring binder for handouts. We do have lockers where you can keep your school materials, boots and work clothes. You are expected to have them on/ready before the beginning class bell rings.
- 8. Be attentive during instruction.
- 9. Complete assignments on time. You will have a deadline to complete each project.
